Sedation forms and Releases

- > PLEASE KEEP WHITE SHEETS AND RETURN ALL GREEN FORMS 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR APPOINTMENT.
- A NON REFUNDABLE SEDATION DEPOSIT of \$500 WILL BE REQUIRED 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO APPOINTMENT. FAILURE TO RETURN FORMS, RELEASES AND PLACE SEDATION DEPOSIT WILL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF APPOINTMENT (The \$500 will be put towards the cost of your treatment but should you fail to show for your appointment or cancel short notice less than 48 hours the deposit is nonrefundable.)

48 HOURS BEFORE YOUR DENTAL PROCEDURE

- 1. Your dentist will give you 3 pages that YOU must read through carefully and fill out. You may be asked to have an extra health form to be filled out by your **FAMILY DOCTOR**.
- 2. Once all pages have been filled out, please deliver the GREEN forms or have all pages faxed to your dentist's office. This 4 page form must be received by the dental office 2 weeks prior to your procedure.
- 3. If you fax forms to your dental office please bring the original copy with you the day of your procedure.
- 4. If you are 60 years of age or older you must have your family doctor complete an ECG and chest x-ray prior to your procedure. These results need to be faxed to your dentist's office.
- 5. If you change your mind about your procedure please give a minimum of 48 hours' notice. This enables us a chance to schedule another patient in your time.

THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE

- 1. DO NOT eat or drink anything 6 HOURS PRIOR to your appointment.
- 2. DO NOT consume any alcoholic beverages or take any drugs the day before your procedure.
- 3. DO NOT chew gum or tobacco, suck mints, or sip water, 6 hours prior to your appointment.
- 4. If you become ill before your appointment please notify your dentist's office at once.

THE DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE

- 1. Please remove all fingernail polish and leave all jewelry and valuables at home.
- 2. Wear clothing that will be loose and comfortable during your procedure.
- 3. If you are taking any medication on a regular basis, please take them with a **SIP** of water in the morning. (Just a sip of water for pills, NOT a glass of water)

AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE

- 1. You **MUST** be accompanied home by a responsible adult who can be contacted at any time after your procedure. A responsible adult must be with you for the first 24 hours after your procedure.
- 2. You MUST NOT drive or travel home alone by bus or taxi.
- 3. **DO NOT** drive or operate power tools or machinery for at least 24 hours.
- 4. Avoid making important decisions or signing important papers for at least 24 hours.
- 5. **DO NOT** drink alcohol; take any sleeping pills or tranquilizers for at least 24 hours.
